5.	Purpose and legal basis for the processing of personal data	The participant and contact register is considered to serve the public interest (Universities Act 558/2007 2§) and legitimate interest of the Data Controller.
		For events, the legal basis for the processing of personal data is set by an agreement that is formed between the Data Controller and the Data Subject (participant) through the registration.
		The purpose of the register is to store information for communication, dissemination, statistics and reporting related to the Finland–Africa Platform for Innovation (SDG 9) (FAPI). When you have registered for an event, data collected from you can be utilised in communication related to the event and networking after the event, for instance for matchmaking, event invitations, newsletter distribution, reporting, and other information sharing enhancing the collaboration under FAPI.

Categories of personal data	The collected personal data varies according to the purpose, typically these would include: - Basic information, such as name; - Profession-related: title/position, affiliation/institution; - Contact information including email address. - Information appearing in presentation slides.
