



The purpose of this Privacy Notice is to provide information on the Personal Data that is collected by Coordinator of the Finland–Africa Platform for Innovation (SDG 9). It gives you an overview of what kind of Personal Data are collected and for what purposes, how we store your Personal Data and how we guarantee their protection.

5. Purpose and legal basis for the processing of personal data	<p>The participant and contact register is considered to serve the public interest (Universities Act 558/2007 2§) and legitimate interest of the Data Controller.</p> <p>For events, the legal basis for the processing of personal data is set by an agreement that is formed between the Data Controller and the Data Subject (participant) through the registration.</p> <p>The purpose of the register is to store information for communication, dissemination, statistics and reporting related to the Finland–Africa Platform for Innovation (SDG 9) (FAPI). When you have registered for an event, data collected from you can be utilised in communication related to the event and networking after the event, for instance for matchmaking, event invitations, newsletter distribution, reporting, and other information sharing enhancing the collaboration under FAPI.</p>
6. Categories of personal data	<p>The collected personal data varies according to the purpose, typically these would include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Basic information, such as name; - Profession-related: title/position, affiliation/institution; - Contact information including email address. - Information appearing in presentation slides.
7. Recipients and recipient groups of personal data	<p>Webropol Oy (Webropol is the system supplier for the University’s Query and Event Management System. It is used for questionnaires and collecting event-related data.)</p> <p>FAPI Coordination Team</p>



	Registered data can be disclosed to organisers or instructors of an event that a you have registered for.
8. Transfer of data	Due to the nature of the cooperation, the data can be transferred to and processed in countries outside of the EU/EEA. For the principles related to the protection of the register, please see point 14.
9. Retention period of personal data	Personal data is stored in the register until one year after the end of the FAPI project. It can be stored longer if there is a legislative or other obligation originating from outside the University (for example, terms stated by the funder of a training event), which requires a longer retention period for personal data.
10. Your rights as a Data Subject	<p>You have the right to access your personal data retained by the Data Controller, the right to rectification or erasure of data, and the right to restrict or object the processing of data, and the right to transfer the data from one controller to another.</p> <p>You have the right to make a complaint with the supervisory authority.</p> <p>The contact person in matters regarding your rights and obligations is the Data Protection Officer, whose contact information is listed at the beginning of this privacy notice.</p>
11. Refusal to provide personal data and consequences for not providing the data	If you do not provide the requested data to a questionnaire or for the registration to an event, the Data Controller cannot accept your participation in the questionnaire/event.
12. Source of personal data	Personal data is collected through your answers in a questionnaire or through your registration to an event.
13. Existence of automatic decision-making, including profiling	Registered data will not be used for automatic decision-making or profiling.
14. Principles of protection of the register	<p>The register data is stored according to best practices, good information security and legislative regulations so that it is protected from external parties. Principles for the protection of personal data: https://www.utu.fi/en/privacy/data-security-description</p> <p>Regarding the transfer of personal data in the context of network events and networking outside of the EU/EEA, the level of protection provided by the EU General Data Protection Regulation cannot necessarily be guaranteed by the Data Controller.</p>

	<p>An agreement on the terms regarding the processing of personal data, which is in accordance with the EU Data Protection Regulation, has been made with the system supplier Webropol Oy.</p> <p>The use of the service creates log entries which are used for ensuring the information security of the service, developing the technology of the service, and for detecting, preventing or investigating technical faults or errors (Sections 138, 141, 144, and 272 of the Information Society Code (917/2014). The logs are retained for these purposes for the required time period and they will not be used for any other purposes.</p>
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
